Connecting Chapters will equip Nebraska high school FFA Chapters to connect with their local elementary school to increase agricultural literacy in their communities.

Participating Chapters will:

- 1. Complete one virtual or in-person training.
- 2. Read and donate a book to an elementary classroom.
- 3. Plan and lead one agricultural literacy activity in their local school.
- 4. Connect with local County Farm Bureau to learn more about Nebraska Farm Bureau and receive a community connection.
- 5. Submit a video about the Connecting Chapters experience.

Participating Chapters will receive:

- 1. Guidebook with lessons & activities.
- 2. Teaching materials to lead lessons & activities.
- 3. A connection to local community leaders.
- 4. Recognition at the State FFA Convention.

All program materials and training are provided at no cost. **Program begins September 1**.

The total service time commitment is 10 hrs.

Agricultural literacy is not only important for educating and informing future consumers so they are aware of where their food comes from, it will also inspire and equip students to explore future careers in agriculture.
